

## **A classic boat is any vessel with 'unique and enduring qualities'**

Yorke Peninsula's Saltwater Classic is a special event designed to tap into growing national and international appreciation and enjoyment of wooden and classic boats. These vessels have been faithfully restored by their owners, and they showcase the skills and styles of boat builders from last century.

The regatta is open to all sail and power boats, but with a focus on classic craft. The Australian Maritime Museum defines a classic boat as "any vessel with unique and enduring qualities." Put simply, beauty is in the eye of the beholder!

Organised by the Stansbury and Port Vincent Wooden & Classic Boats Regatta Association, the biennial event attracts people from across Australia to parade their boats in the waters off the sister towns of Stansbury and Port Vincent, and it draws spectators to a variety of water-based and shore-based attractions.

The next regatta will be held on the weekend of April 17 and 18, 2010. While the focus is on Stansbury and Port Vincent – less than three hours drive from Adelaide – visitors are encouraged to venture on to other appealing places on Yorke Peninsula.

SA's Tall Ship One & All is again scheduled to be the flagship of the 2010 regatta as part of its youth development program. Yorke Peninsula's Saltwater Classic is supported by the South Australian Tourism Commission, Yorke Peninsula Tourism Marketing, the Stansbury and Port Vincent Progress Committees, Australian Volunteer Coast Guard, South Australian Sea Rescue Squadron and various businesses.

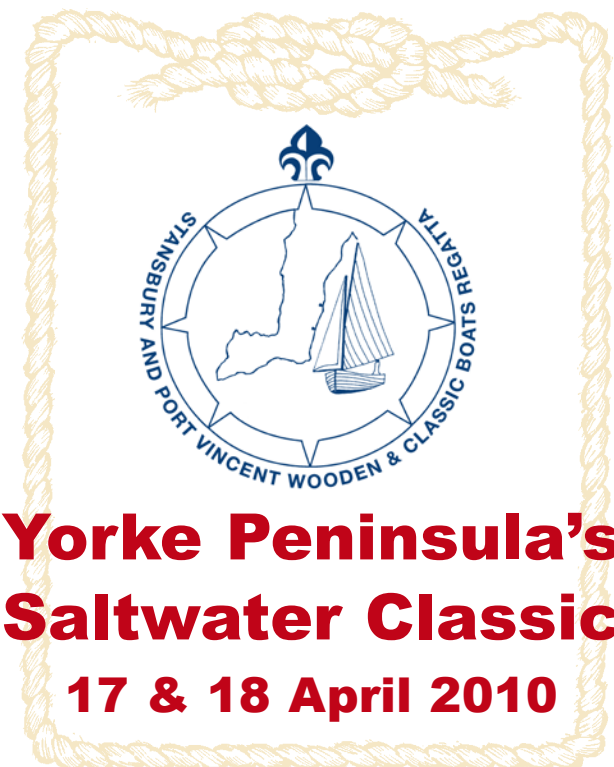

# Official Program

## Friday 16 April

**5.00pm - 7.00pm** – Welcome reception for registered entrants and crews at Port Vincent School and adjacent Marine Centre

## Saturday 17 April

**9.00am - 3.00pm** – Extensive foreshore and on-water events in Port Vincent. This will include a public breakfast and open inspection of boats at the marina, parades of vessels in the bay, foreshore displays of classic caravans and motor bikes, art, crafts, entertainment and other attractions including refreshments in the institute thanks to the CWA.

**6.30pm - 11.30pm** – Official dinner for registered regatta participants at Stansbury Institute. Note: \$25 per head. Pre-booking essential. A bus service will run between Port Vincent and Stansbury before and after the dinner.

## Sunday 18 April

**9.00am** – Regatta run from Port Vincent Marina to Oyster Bay, Stansbury arriving approximately 11.30am as the Stansbury Seaside Markets and foreshore exhibits are in full swing. Note: Entrants wishing to take cars and trailers to Stansbury early on Sunday morning can use the special bus to return to the Port Vincent marina in time for the regatta run.

**9.00am to 3.00pm** – Award-winning Stansbury Seaside Markets, foreshore exhibition of participating boats from the regatta along with vintage and veteran cars and motorbikes, classic caravans, restored stationary engines, diverse exhibits, entertainment, artworks, displays of working with wood and local produce.
